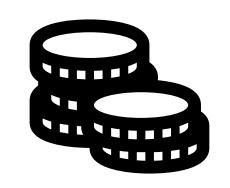

Pros

- Professional, specialist casework for guests.
- Casework vital to be separated out from hosts and also needed for move on plan.
- SLA's in place with all key agencies.
- Placement confirmation document outlining our role and support worker's role.
- Working with other agencies means greater capacity for both agencies.

Cons

- Can't guarantee quality of casework or referrals.
- High turnover of casework staff in some organisations.
- Sometimes have to adapt to fit with processes of partners.
